1. What is a I4C BIOHACKATHON?

I4C BIOHACKATHON aims to involve young innovators with ideas aligning with the concept of the **COW IN THE CAR** project and with potential to be converted into marketable products and technologies. This constitutes NIRDA's contribution to promote entrepreneurship and to bridge the gap between job market and the unemployed youth.

I4C BIOHACKATHON will solve some of the pressing problems we face in our daily lives, and thus inculcate a culture of product innovation and a mindset of problem-solving. This competition will drive to a sustainable innovation to address real life problems and social issues. Thus, we can inculcate a culture of product innovation and mindset of problem solving into the aspiring student community.

2. Who can participate?

Student, graduate, university staff or other innovators working in life sciences and STEM with cow product and by-products related innovations and with an interest technology in cow value chain, at most 35 years old.

4. What is in for me?

winning teams will be awarded with prizes and given an opportunity to be incubated for 12 weeks (at STEM 4 Industry hub(S4I) or Huye research center) and develop/refine their prototypes prior to large scale production and commercialization

5. How are the winners selected?

Teams will apply and there will be preliminary selection based on selection criteria set, the pre-selected participants will have opportunity to pitch their idea to the Jury for the final selection.

6. Who will be judging?

The panel expert with different background and from different institution.

7. How many people should a Team be?

Applicants should be in team of 2 or 3 members with at least one female and 2 out of 3 team members should be enrolled in university or university graduate

8. What are the costs of participating?

The application is free of charges
